Access in Action: Connecting Neighbors to Nutritious Food

Every day, the Blue Ridge Area Food Bank works to ensure that nutritious food reaches neighbors—wherever they live. Through several mobile distribution programs, we remove barriers while providing reliable, convenient access to healthy groceries for thousands of people across our region.

Mobile Food Pantry sites deliver food to communities where access to grocery stores and food assistance resources may be limited, particularly in rural areas.

Neighborhood Produce Markets increase access to fresh fruits and vegetables for neighbors living in areas with limited food options or transportation challenges.

We also distribute food at **Remote Area Medical (RAM) Clinics**, helping patients access nutritious groceries alongside the healthcare services they receive.

For many neighbors, barriers—including transportation, distance, language, mobility, and stigma—make it difficult to seek assistance. That is why the Food Bank continues to build new partnerships and develop creative distribution models that bring food closer to the people who need it most.

By meeting neighbors where they are, we can ensure that nutritious food is accessible to all. Your generosity makes this work possible. *Thank you* for helping create pathways to food access while building healthier, stronger communities.

Mobile Food Distribution Guest Snapshot

July 2025 - June 2026



4,350 guests served each month, on average, at **Mobile Food Pantry** sites.



2,240 guest visits each month, on average, at **Neighborhood Produce Market** sites.



2,290 guests served at **Remote Area Medical Clinics** last year.



Mobile Food Pantry

The Mobile Food Pantry delivers fresh produce, protein, and nutritious staples to families, seniors, and children living in rural counties in the Blue Ridge region. This Food Bank program is about much more than just providing food—it's about ensuring that everyone, regardless of where they live, has access to the nourishment they need to thrive. **In 2026, we distributed more than 1 million pounds of food at Mobile Food Pantry sites.**



Neighborhood Produce Markets

These farmers market-style produce distributions take place in neighborhoods where access to fresh food is limited. Guests can choose from a variety of produce options, which are tailored to the needs and cultural preferences of the neighborhood. **In 2026, we distributed 167,800 pounds of food at Neighborhood Produce Market sites.**



Remote Area Medical Clinics

Remote Area Medical (RAM) is a national organization that provides free healthcare services through mobile pop-up clinics. RAM clinics deliver quality healthcare and dental services to underserved and uninsured individuals who do not have access to healthcare. The Food Bank partners with RAM to provide fresh produce and shelf-stable items to patients. **In 2026, we distributed 35,100 pounds of food at 3 RAM clinics.**

Fresh produce is a top priority for the Food Bank. With your support, we're working to ensure that fruits and vegetables are available to every neighbor. Last year, we distributed **11 million pounds of fresh produce** through our network of partners and programs.
